
Introduction

The Hi5 converts SDI or HD-SDI to HDMI for driving HDMI monitors. Embedded SDI/HD-SDI audio is supported in the HDMI output allowing a convenient single cable audio/video connection. The Hi5 provides 2 Channel RCA style audio outputs for separate audio monitoring if needed. The Hi5 also provides a looping SDI/HD-SDI output useful for connecting additional equipment, or for "daisy chaining" multiple monitors to the same SDI-HD-SDI source.

- Additional 2 Channel RCA jack audio output (channels 1 and 2)
- Equalized Looping SDI/HD-SDI output


User Controls

An internal Jumper block with 3 jumpers (J4) provides controls for HDMI audio, output mode, and 480i/480p selection. Each of these settings are described below.

Internal Jumper

Jumper #1 (default = installed)	Jumper #2 (default = installed)	Jumper #3 (default = installed)
Installed (default) = SD output is interlaced (480i/576i) Removed = SD output is progressive (480p/576p) Some HDMI monitors do not support 480i/576i. The Hi5 can line-double SD inputs to 480p/576p (support for 480p/576p is required by HDMI). 480i/576i is recommended for monitors which do support it	Installed (default) = HDMI output mode Removed = DVI output mode DVI mode should be used only with DVI-only monitors. Note that most DVI monitors do not work with video rates. Embedded audio is not supported in DVI mode.	Installed (default) = 2-channel HDMI audio Removed = 8-channel HDMI audio The jumper selects whether 2 or 8 channels of audio will be embedded onto the HDMI output stream. Channels 1 and 2 will always appear on the RCA connectors, regardless of the jumper setting. When the jumper is set for 2-channel HDMI embedded audio, channels 1 and 2 are disembedded from SDI. When the jumper is set for 8-channel HDMI embedded audio, channels 1 through 8 are disembedded from SDI.

To access this jumper, remove the four phillips screws securing the back side of the Hi5 case. Once the case cover is removed, locate the jumper block. Jumper positions 1 through 3 are clearly marked on the circuit board next to the jumper J4.



[Note: "Removed" jumpers can be stored inside the unit by installing them on only 1 pin

Installation

Typically, Hi5 installation consists of the following steps:

- 1. Ensure the Hi5 is disconnected from power.
- 2. Connect video equipment to the convertor BNCs and HDMI connector.
- 3. Connect audio equipment to RCA connectors (optional)
- **4.** Apply +5VDC power to the converter (AJA power supply model DWP or DWP-U).
